FALL GARDENING CHORE LIST

Plant:

- Trees and native plants
- Spring bulbs
- Garlic
- Winter Vegetables
- Divide perennials
- Harvest fruits, vegetables, and herbs
- Gather (purchase, collect, or swap) seeds for planting and winter sowing
- Dig tender bulbs and perennials and store
- Protect veggies from early frost
- Protect trees from varmints and pests for the winter
- Take cuttings for next year
- Bring your houseplants inside for the year
- Amend your gardens for next year
- Set up cold frames, greenhouses, etc.
- Don't forget to continue weeding before those weeds set seed!
- Rake the yard utilize the leaves in pathways, mulch, or compost.
- Save seeds from your favorite annuals, perennials and vegetables
- Apply mulch everywhere
- Empty, clean and store birdbaths and annual containers
- Clean and fertilize houseplants
- Store garden hoses, winterize outside spigots and irrigation.
